25 TEACHERS SELECTED TO PARTICIPATE IN DIGITAL VIDEO IN THE CLASSROOM GRANT

The Southtown Teachers' Center is pleased to announce that 25 teachers, representing each of the 19 school buildings in our consortium, have been selected to participate in our **Digital Video in the Classroom** grant. This grant is the first offering in our newly implemented **Targeted Technology Grant** program.

The purpose of this program is to promote the use of technology in the classroom by putting the technology into the hands of classroom teachers and having them develop lessons and activities that will then be collected by the Teachers' Center and made available to all of the teachers in the consortium.

Each participant in the grant will be receiving a Flip Video Ultra camcorder.

After attending a short training session to learn how to use the camera, each participant will be charged with the task of developing and submitting two lessons or activities that use digital video to address NYS Learning Standards along with a sample video file.



Each participant has signed an agreement indicating that they will abide by their school or district's photo/video release guidelines in using the Video camcorder.
